Eligibility of Blind and Other Physically Disabled Persons for Loan of Library Materials

The following persons are eligible for service provided they are residents of the United States, including territories, insular possessions, the District of Columbia, or American citizens living abroad:

- 1. Blind persons whose visual acuity, as determined by competent authority, is 20/200 or less in the better eye with correcting lenses, or whose widest diameter of visual field subtends an angular distance no greater than 20 degrees.
- 2. Other physically disabled persons are eligible as follows:
 - A. Persons whose visual disability, with correction and regardless of optical measurement, is certified by competent authority as preventing the reading of regular printed material.
 - B. Persons certified by competent authority as unable to read or unable to use regular printed material because of physical limitations.
 - C. Persons certified by competent authority as having a reading disability resulting from organic dysfunction and of sufficient severity to prevent reading regular printed material in a conventional manner.

Eligible Applicants

Nursing homes, hospitals, schools for the blind, public and private schools, and college/university disability centers may borrow equipment and reading materials for use by eligible patrons in either a group setting or for individual use. The institution is responsible for keeping a record of the serial numbers of all machines assigned to the institution. Eligible residents, not the institution, are responsible for equipment borrowed directly using individual applications.

Public or private schools and college/university centers where disabled students are enrolled are encouraged to submit individual applications but may use this form accompanied by certification of eligibility for each applicant.

For music materials, e.g., scores, instructional recordings, and music magazines, the individual application must be submitted.

Lending of Materials and Classes of Borrowers

Veterans. In the lending of books, recordings, playback equipment, musical scores, instructional texts, and other specialized materials, preference shall be given at all times to the needs of the blind and other physically disabled persons who have been honorably discharged from the armed forces of the United States.

Institutions. Institutions such as schools, residential care facilities, hospitals, and other establishments regularly attended by blind and/or physically disabled individuals may borrow special format reading materials and playback equipment solely for the use of persons certified as eligible, who must be the direct and only recipients of the materials and equipment provided by the National Library Service.
